

### What?

To what extend do pupils (with and without migration background) show interest in the integration of other languages in English lessons?

#### How?

A questionnaire conducted in six classes (117 pupils) between 5th and 8th grade in two *Oberschulen* in Bremen.

Fig. 2: Language(s) spoken at home by pupils with migration background (multiple answers possible)

Fig.3: Experiences in comparing other languages, apart from German, to English (e.g. grammar)




Fig. 4 and 5: Interest in including other languages than German in English classes

## Conclusion

- Pupils with and without migration background do not differ much in their degree of interest in including further languages in English classes.
- Interest in "multilingualism" was relatively high on average, but varies considerably between classes, as does the linguistic composition (30 languages were specified in this study).
- Inclusion of other languages in English lessons should be carried out with attention to individual needs and interests.
