Excursion to "Shakespeare's London and Shakespeare's Globe"

We will discuss, among other topics,

- what we will be doing on the excursion
- what will you need to do in advance of and after the excursion
- how you get credit points: what are the requirements
- how much it will cost you
- how it will be decided who takes part
- who from the staff will probably be taking part.
